28 March 2020 Maharashtra - State govt to raise rural spending to over Rs 1 lakh crore to offset impact of Covid-19 Maharashtra government is planning to spend nearly 10 per cent of its annual budget of Rs 1.5 lakh crore on uplift of poor farmers, who will be given some financial support to tide over Covid-19 crisis. Pradip Desai, who is in charge of the Centre's social security ministry, said the rural spending will be enhanced to Rs 1,000 crore as an effort to spend Rs 1,000 crore per year in each of the state's 53 districts. The state government is expected to spend a total of Rs 8,000 crore on Jan-Dhan Yojana and other programmes to help the rural poor during the next fiscal. While the centre is planning to spend Rs 15,000 crore in the upcoming budget, in the state it will be nearly Rs 10,000 crore.
